



Toddler and Primary students experience summer fun and exploration at MIR

The MIR Toddler and Primary Summer Program provides continuity in your child’s education and consistency in their environment while providing plenty of summer fun.

Toddlers will supplement their Montessori environment with special summer activities including gardening, crafts, and water play. An outing to the San Bernardino County Museum will enhance their summer fun.

Primary students will incorporate the Montessori philosophy and materials with summer activities such as cooking, gardening, and sporting activities. All-day Primary students have the opportunity to take swimming lessons in the afternoon for the first three summer sessions. Whether beginning or advanced, students will develop a joy for swimming, appreciation of the water, and improved ability in the pool. A minimum of one field trip per session will complete students’ summer exploration.

Session I: June 21–July 2 ☀ Session II: July 6–July 16 ☀ Session III: July 19–July 30 ☀ Session IV: August 2–13

There is no school and no childcare August 16-27. The 2010-2011 school year begins August 30.

WHO CAN ENROLL

The summer program is open to continuing students and to new students registered for the 2010–2011 school year.

HOW TO ENROLL

Complete all forms and bring them to the office along with your \$100 deposit. *This is a non-refundable deposit that applies toward summer school only.* Sessions 1 and 2 will be billed in July, and sessions 3 and 4 will be billed in August.

WHEN TO ENROLL

Early-bird enrollment is open to existing families March 18–April 16. New families registered for the 2010-2011 school year may enroll starting April 16. Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis. **The final deadline for all families is June 1.**

CHILDCARE

Childcare is available 7:15-9:00 AM and 3–6 PM except for two-day students. Drop-in childcare before and after class requires 24-hour notice, space permitting. The drop-in childcare rate is:

- With 24hr. notice: \$9.50 per hour (1 hour min.)
- With less than 24hr. notice: \$14.50 per hour (1 hour min.)

LUNCHES

Please bring a nutritious lunch and beverage for your child everyday. Lunch and beverages are not offered by the school.

SWIMMING (PRIMARY STUDENTS ONLY)

The child’s parent/guardian must sign a swim waiver for the child to participate. Lessons are given at Redlands High School on Redlands Blvd. and Fern Ave. Please read the Swim Information for complete details regarding our Swim Program. Swimming is not available during Summer Session 4.

FIELD TRIPS

All field trips will occur on Fridays, and parents are welcome to chaperone.

Field trips will be billed separately. Field trips and transportation are planned in advance on the assumption that all children in the class will participate. Students are encouraged to wear their blue MIR school t-shirt on all outings and field trips.
