

Primary students enjoy fun and exploration in the MIR Summer Program

Session 1: June 18–29 ☀ Session 2: July 2–13 ☀ Session 3: July 16–27 ☀ Session 4: July 30–August 10

Primary-age children (2 1/2 to 6 years) seem like they never stop moving or exploring, and the MIR summer program provides plenty of fun and engaging activities in addition to their regular Montessori program.

Your child will enjoy the consistency of their Montessori environment, supplemented by special summer activities such as cooking, gardening, sporting activities, and an in-depth look at subjects such as sea life and art. Field trips provide opportunities for exploration in the wider world as well as old-fashioned summer fun.

Full- and All-day students will take **swimming lessons** (making it one less activity you have to manage on your own). Whether beginning or advanced, students will develop a joy for swimming,

appreciation of the water, and improved ability in the pool.

The summer program is open to continuing Primary students and to new students enrolled for the 2012–2013 school year.



WHEN AND HOW TO ENROLL

Registration for current MIR families begins April 2. The deposit for families who register before April 30 is \$100. All families who register after April 30 will be required to pay the full amount of the first session attending at the time of registration.

New families may register starting May 1 and will be required to pay the full amount of the first session attending.

Deposits are non-refundable and apply toward summer school fees only.

To enroll, complete all registration forms and bring them to the office along with your required deposit. Enrollment is first-come, first-served. The last days to make changes are as follows: Session 1 – May 25; Session 2 – June 15; Session 3 – June 29; and Session 4 – July 13.

SWIMMING

Full- and All-day Primary students take swimming lessons in the afternoon for the first three summer sessions and the first week of Session 4. (*Swimming is not available during the second week of Session 4.*) You must sign a swim waiver for your child. Lessons will be given at one of Redlands' high school campuses (location to be determined).

CHILDCARE

Childcare is available 7:15-9 AM and 5-6 PM. Drop-in childcare before and after class requires 24-hour notice, space permitting. The drop-in childcare rate is:

- With 24hr. notice: \$9.50 per hour (1 hour min.)
- With less than 24hr. notice: \$14.50 per hour (1 hour min.)

LUNCHES

Please bring a nutritious lunch for your child everyday. Beverages are provided by the school.

FIELD TRIPS

All field trips will occur on Fridays, and parents are welcome to chaperone. Students are encouraged to wear their blue MIR school t-shirt on all outings and field trips.
